A walk through the woods along the Messalonskee Stream...

Built by the Maine Conservation Corps and the Town of Oakland's Parks & Recreation Department, the 2 mile footpath follows the gentle slopes above the stream. Cross several log bridges on the trail and hike boardwalks protecting marsh areas at streamside. Plans call for the trail to connect with the Rice Rips Road with access at both ends, but for now, hikers can plan on a round trip that can be up to 4 miles long.

Park in the fenced in lot, located off Kennedy Memorial Drive just before the Messalonskee Stream bridge in Oakland.

Kennebec Messalonskee Trails is pleased to include this new trail in the 24 mile system that will connect Fairfield, Oakland, Waterville, Winslow and Benton. As a non profit organization, there is always a need for more volunteers. Come walk with us. Come bike with us. Come join us.
